
INFORMATION SHEET ON THE PURPOSE OF ACTIVITIES TO COLLECT INFORMATION

En-route questionnaire

The purpose of this questionnaire is to characterize socio-demographic profiles and gather information about the preferences of pilgrims and tourists in relation to resources located in the vicinity of the routes they are traveling. The aim is to conduct research to identify the most appropriate resources to recommend to each individual or groups, and the organizational aspects that need to be implemented or improved (in terms of transport, accommodation, meals, etc.) to meet the most common needs.

Throughout this questionnaire, we will ask about:

- Personal data: Origin, languages, academic training, work, companions, etc.
- Interests in certain aspects of cultural and natural heritage.
- Interest in activities that may be done by taking detours into the rural surroundings of the route.
- Elements that could influence the decision to engage in the aforementioned activities: duration, distance, cost, availability of guides, etc.

The questionnaire is entirely anonymous, and all the data will be processed and stored in compliance with EU regulations to prevent the guessing of any identities.

Basic information on data protection
